From Ft. Lauderdale

- Head south on I-95 to Miami
- Keep right at the fork to stay on I-95S, follow signs for US 441/Florida 9/Florida 826/Florida Turnpike
- Take exit 12 for US-441 S/FL-9/FL-826 E
- Keep right at the fork, follow signs for FL-826 W and merge onto FL-826W
- Continue onto FL-826 W
- Keep right at the fork to continue on FL-826S, follow signs for Kendall
- Exit onto FL-94 E/SW 88th St/N Kendall Dr
- Go two (2) blocks east, take a right onto Dadeland Blvd
- First light, take a right onto South Dadeland Blvd. The Dadeland Marriott hotel will be on your left and Publix grocery store on your right.
- Stay in the right lane and go straight on Dadeland Blvd
- You will be entering the Dadeland Towers office complex
- Bear right entering the traffic circle
- Make the 1st immediate right
- At the circle make the 2nd left to the complimentary valet stand
- IPC is located in the first building on the right (9200 building)

From Miami International - Using US-1

- Exit Airport from right lane to LeJeune Road South
- Remain on LeJeune to U.S. 1 (South Dixie Hwy)
- Turn right onto U.S.1 – proceed to SW 90th Street (Dadeland Blvd)
- Turn right onto Dadeland Blvd, before the Shorty's BBQ Restaurant
- At the next traffic light, make a left. The Dadeland Marriott hotel will be on your left and Publix on your right
- Stay in the right lane and go straight on Dadeland Blvd
- You will be entering the Dadeland Towers office complex
- Bear right entering the traffic circle
- Make the 1st immediate right
- At the circle make the 2nd left to the complimentary valet stand
- IPC is located in the first building on the right (9200 building)

From Miami International Airport - Using highway/expressways

- From Miami International Airport, exit onto LeJeune Road (right hand lane)
- From LeJeune – enter onto SR836 W two (2) miles to SR826 S (Palmetto Expressway)
- Eight (8) miles to Kendall Drive EAST exit
- Two (2) blocks east, take a right at light to Dadeland Blvd
- First light, take a right onto South Dadeland Blvd. The Dadeland Marriott hotel will be on your left and Publix on your right
- Stay in the right lane and go straight on Dadeland Blvd
- You will be entering the Dadeland Towers office complex
- Bear right entering the traffic circle
- Make the 1st immediate right
- At the circle make the 2nd left to the complimentary valet stand

From Bal Harbour/Miami Beach

- Take Broad Causeway (125th Street) to I-95 S.
- Get on I-95 South; proceed all the way to the end

- Proceed to SW 90th Street (Dadeland Blvd.) Turn right onto Dadeland Blvd. and go to next traffic light

Zoo Miami is the largest and oldest zoological garden in Florida, and the only sub-tropical zoo in the continental United States. The unique climate in South Florida allows a wide variety of animals from Asia, Australia and Africa, representing a broad mix of species that is unlike any other zoo in the country. The animals are grouped according to their geographic territories with species that live together peacefully in the wild placed in exhibits together at the zoo. The trees, foliage and even soil are matched as closely as possible to the native habitats of these animals. As one of the first free-range zoos in the United States, Zoo Miami's exhibits are entirely cageless.
